

S.B. 137
PHYSICAL THERAPY PRACTICE ACT

Representative **Gregory H. Hughes** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 15, Lines 441 through 446:*

- 441 (xvii) activities of daily living related to physical movement and mobility ; and
442 (xviii) functioning in the physical environment at home or work , as it relates to physical movement
and mobility .
443 (14) "Therapeutic intervention" includes:
444 (a) therapeutic exercise, with or without the use of a device;
445 (b) functional training in self-care , as it relates to physical movement and mobility ;
446 (c) community or work integration , as it relates to physical movement and mobility ;
