30	Part 3a. Nonrecognition of Foreign Judgments
31	78B-5-320. Grounds for nonrecognition of libel judgments.
32	A judgment obtained in a foreign jurisdiction may be considered nonrecognizable and
33	unenforceable by the courts of this state if:
34	(1) the judgment was obtained in a jurisdiction outside the United States;
35	(2) the judgment resulted in a libel judgment for damages; and
36	(3) the court sitting in this state before which the matter is brought determines that the
37	libel law applied in the foreign court's adjudication process did not provide at least as much
38	protection for freedom of speech and press as would be provided by the United States
39	Constitution and the Utah Constitution.
