*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **67-1a-13** is enacted to read:

**67-1a-13. Certification restrictions.**

The lieutenant governor may not certify:

(1) a document that is not properly notarized; or

(2) a document regarding:



- 28        (a) allegiance to a government or jurisdiction;  
29        (b) sovereignty;  
30        (c) in itinere status or world service authority; or  
31        (d) a claim similar to a claim listed in Subsections (2)(a) through (c).
