LONG TITLE

This bill enacts a provision relating to the duties of the lieutenant governor.

▶ prohibits the lieutenant governor from certifying a document in certain circumstances.

ENACTS:

67-1a-13, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **67-1a-13** is enacted to read:

67-1a-13. Certification restrictions.

The lieutenant governor may not certify a signature of a notary or county recorder on:



- 26 (1) a document that is not properly notarized, if notarization is required; or
- 27 (2) a document regarding:
- 28 (a) allegiance to a government or jurisdiction;
- 29 (b) sovereignty;
- 30 (c) in itinere status or world service authority; or
- 31 (d) a claim similar to a claim listed in Subsections (2)(a) through (c).
