30	Section 1. Section 31A-22-322 is enacted to read:
31	31A-22-322. Lienholder notification of insurance policy lapse for nonpayment.
32	(1) An insurance company that gives a notice of cancellation of insurance on a motor
33	vehicle insurance coverage policy issued in accordance with the requirements of this part for
34	nonpayment or nonrenewal of a premium shall immediately notify the lienholder, if any, of the
35	nonpayment or nonrenewal.
36	(2) The notice described in Subsection (1) shall be provided to the lienholder by first
37	class mail or other electronic means of communication.
38	(3) A lienholder shall provide a current physical address of notification or an electronic
39	address of notification to an insurance company that is required to make a notification under
40	Subsection (1).
41	(4) Nonpayment under Subsection (1) includes drafts, checks, or other payment
42	instruments that are not honored at a financial institution for any reason.
