Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
WHEREAS, Utah's veteran population and the American Legion give thanks to the
Utah Legislature and the Governor for their \$19,700,000 appropriation as seed money to help
facilitate the construction of a second needed nursing home for veterans located in Ogden,
Utah;
WHEREAS, now that the federal grant nursing home funds for construction costs of the

28	Ogden facility are expected in the near future, the state seed money will be returned to the State
29	Treasurer;
30	WHEREAS, Utah is still significantly below the national average for the total number
31	of needed veterans' nursing homes statewide, with a need for at least two more to be located in
32	central and southern Utah; and
33	WHEREAS, for every state dollar invested in the construction of a veterans' nursing
34	home there is at least a two dollar return from federal funds to the state:
35	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah
36	supports using federal construction money, received for reimbursement of the new veterans'
37	nursing home facility in Ogden, Utah, to construct a central or southern Utah veterans' nursing
38	home under the same reimbursement conditions that apply to the present project.
