31	field trips, where they will experience a complete educational program hosted at the facility;

33	\$1,500,000;

35	supportive non-profit organizations;
36	WHEREAS, to date, approximately \$300,000 in cash and in-kind donations has been
37	raised;

39	of its scope and ways to assist in the planning, funding, and furthering of the project; and
