

Senator Dennis E. Stowell proposes the following substitute bill:

MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT REPORTS

2010 GENERAL SESSION

LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies the Traffic Code by amending provisions relating to motor vehicle accident reports.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- requires a peace officer investigating an accident resulting in injury or death of any livestock to make arrangements with the owner of the livestock to:
 - deliver, mail, email, fax, or otherwise provide the owner of the livestock a copy of the accident report prepared in accordance with Section 41-6a-404; or
 - advise the owner of the livestock where a copy of the accident report prepared in accordance with Section 41-6a-404 may be obtained; and
- makes technical changes.

28 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

29 Section 1. Section **41-6a-408** is amended to read:

30 **41-6a-408. Peace officer investigating accident to notify owner if livestock or**
31 **broken fence involved -- Exempt from liability.**

32 (1) A peace officer investigating an accident resulting in injury or death of any
33 livestock shall make reasonable efforts as soon as possible to:

34 (a) locate the owner of the livestock [~~and~~];

35 (b) inform the owner of the injured or dead animal[:]; and

36 (c) (i) make arrangements with the owner of the livestock to deliver, mail, email, fax,
37 or otherwise provide the owner of the livestock a copy of the accident report prepared in
38 accordance with Section 41-6a-404; or

39 (ii) advise the owner of the livestock where a copy of the accident report prepared in
40 accordance with Section 41-6a-404 may be obtained.

41 (2) A peace officer investigating an accident resulting in a broken fence, if it appears
42 the fence contains or controls the movement of livestock, shall make reasonable efforts as soon
43 as possible to locate the owner of the property and inform the owner of the broken fence.

44 (3) (a) Civil or criminal liability for claims does not arise against any peace officer for
45 failure to locate the owner of the livestock or property.

46 (b) Subsection (3)(a) does not preclude disciplinary action by the law enforcement
47 agency against a peace officer for failure to perform duties required by this section.
