**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

This bill modifies the Criminal Code regarding nuisances.

This bill:

► provides that violation of an order or judgment abating or enjoining a nuisance or a public nuisance is a class B misdemeanor.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **76-10-806.5** is enacted to read:

**76-10-806.5. Violation of order enjoining a public nuisance.**

A person who knowingly violates any judgment or order abating or otherwise enjoining a public nuisance as defined under Section 76-10-803 is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.



28 Section 2. Section **78B-6-1102.5** is enacted to read:  
29 **78B-6-1102.5. Violation of order enjoining a nuisance.**  
30 A person who knowingly violates any judgment or order abating or otherwise enjoining  
31 a nuisance as defined under Section 78B-6-1101 is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
