This bill appropriates for FY 2010 \$98,607,300 including (\$34,912,100) from General, Education, and Uniform School Funds. It transfers (\$2,397,200) from the Education Fund to the Uniform School Fund. It deposits \$40,819,600 from various sources, including \$26,910,200 from the General Fund Budget Reserve Account, into the General Fund. It transfers \$59,290,800 from the Education Budget Reserve Account to the Education Fund. These appropriations are made for the use and support of state government and higher education.
