General Description:

This joint resolution of the Legislature fixes the compensation for legislative in-session employees for 2010.

Special Clauses:

This resolution provides retrospective operation to January 4, 2010.

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

WHEREAS, the Legislature acting under the authority of Section 36-2-2, Utah Code Annotated 1953, is required to fix the compensation of its in-session employees by joint resolution:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the state of Utah that the compensation of legislative in-session employees for actual hours worked be fixed as follows:

Employees shall be paid the hourly rate as specified in this resolution.

Employees who are working for the Legislature for the first time shall be paid under the

29 Employees who are working their second annual general session shall be paid under the

30 "Level 2" scale.

31 Employees who are working their third annual general session shall be paid under the

32 "Level 3" scale.

33 Employees who are working their fourth annual general session shall be paid under the

34 "Level 4" scale.

35 Employees who are working their fifth to ninth annual general session shall be paid

36 under the "Level 5" scale.

37 Employees who are working their 10th to 14th annual general session shall be paid

38 under the "Level 6" scale.

39 Employees who are working their 15th to 19th annual general session shall be paid

40 under the "Level 7" scale.

41 Employees who are working their 20th or more annual general session shall be paid

42 under the "Level 8" scale.

43 Senate employees are designated with an "S." House of Representative employees are
