## Mr. Speaker:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 81**, SCHOOL EMPLOYEE CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK, by Representative S. Allen, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 18:
  - applicant or employee to pay for the costs of a criminal background check; {-and-}

     allows the State Board of Education to require an educator to submit to a

     criminal background check where reasonable cause exists; and
- 2. Page 5, Lines 150 through 151:
  - 150 revoked license.
    - (2) Where reasonable cause exists, the State Board of Education may require an educator to submit to a criminal background check.
  - 151 {(2)} (a) The office shall establish a procedure for obtaining and evaluating relevant
- 3. Page 6, Line 159:
  - separate file of fingerprints submitted under Subsection  $\{-(2)\}$  (a) and notify the office when a new
- 4. Page 6, Line 169:
  - 169 { (3) } (4) An applicant or educator shall have an opportunity to respond to any information received by the
- 5. Page 6, Lines 171 through 173:
  - 171 (4) In preparing recommendations concerning licensing for submission to the board,
  - the office shall consider only the following matters obtained through fingerprint checks to the







- extent that they are relevant to the license sought by the applicant or held by the educator:
- 6. Page 7, Lines 185 through 188:
  - 185 (5) If a recommendation is made for denial <u>, suspension, or revocation</u> of licensure because of information
  - obtained through a background check, the person shall receive written notice of the reasons for
  - the recommendation and have an opportunity to respond in accordance with procedures set
  - 188 forth under board rules.
- 7. Page 7, Line 191:
  - 191 (7) The applicant shall pay the costs of conducting the background check required pursuant to Subsection (1) .
