The Political Subdivisions Committee recommends **H.B. 94**, UNIFORM FISCAL PROCEDURES ACT AMENDMENTS FOR TOWNS, CITIES, AND COUNTIES AMENDMENTS, by Representative F. Hunsaker, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 94**, UNIFORM FISCAL PROCEDURES ACT AMENDMENTS FOR TOWNS, CITIES, AND COUNTIES AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 16 through Page 2, Line 26:
 - requires a town council to give public notice and hold a hearing before amending
