Mr. Speaker:

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 312, MEDICAL EXPENSES FOR OFFENDERS**, by Representative P. Ray, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 15 through 18:*

- 15           • for services provided at a health care facility, payment is at ~~{the}~~ {-  
                  **noncapitated**
- 16    ~~state Medicaid rate in effect at the time the service was provided}~~    ~~{60% of the~~  
      ~~amount}~~    the same rate    that would be paid under the Public Employees' Benefit

2. *Page 1, Line 21:*

- 21    private insurer that is in effect at the time of the service    ; and  
      ► The Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program shall provide  
      information to the department that enables the department to calculate the  
      amount to be paid to a health care facility, and this information shall be kept  
      confidential .

3. *Page 3, Lines 61 through 64:*

4. Page 3, Line 67:

(9)(a) The Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program shall provide

be paid to a health care facility under Subsection (7)(a) or a health care provider  
under Subsection (7)(b).

(b) The department shall keep information provided under Subsection (9)(a)  
confidential.
