Mr. Speaker:

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 312**, MEDICAL EXPENSES FOR OFFENDERS, by Representative P. Ray, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 18:
 - for services provided at a health care facility, payment is at {-the-} {-noncapitated}
 - 16 state Medicaid rate in effect at the time the service was provided } { 60% of the mount } the same rate that would be paid under the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program; and
 - for services of a health care provider, payment is at {-110% of the noncapitated}
 - 18 state Medicaid rate in effect at the time the service was provided } ; _ { <u>___65% of the amount } } the same rate that would be paid under the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program; </u> { and }
- 2. Page 1, Line 21:
 - 21 private insurer that is in effect at the time of the service : and
 - ► The Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program shall provide information to the department that enables the department to calculate the amount to be paid to a health care facility, and this information shall be kept confidential.
- 3. Page 3, Lines 61 through 64:
 - 61 (a) service at a health care facility at { the noncapitated state Medicaid rate in effect at

- 63 (b) a health care provider at { 110% of the noncapitated state Medicaid rate in effect at

(b) The department shall keep information provided under Subsection (9)(a) confidential.
