The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 324**, PUBLIC LANDS LITIGATION, by Representative K. Sumsion, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 13:
 - certain eminent domain <u>or quiet title</u> actions to facilitate the state's ability to manage school
- 2. Page 2, Lines 29 through 30:
 - 29 (2) In accordance with Title 78B, Chapter 6, {Part 5, Eminent Domain } Particular Proceedings , the attorney
 - 30 general shall file an eminent domain action <u>or a quiet title action to obtain a judicial</u> <u>declaration of the existence of an easement of access</u> <u>on property possessed by the</u> <u>federal government</u>
- 3. Page 2, Lines 37 through 38:
 - 37 (3) The attorney general shall file an eminent domain action or quiet title action described in Subsection
 - 38 (2) {<u>for a fee simple</u>} on property possessed by the federal government:
- 4. Page 2, Line 40:
 - 40 (i) on Spring Creek Road located in the {western} eastern half of section 3, township 38 south,
- 5. Page 6, Line 177:
 - 177(cxxvi) section 13, except the northeast quarter of the{ southeast }southwest quarter of section 13,
