The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 379**, BARBER, COSMETOLOGIST/BARBER, ESTHETICIAN, ELECTROLOGIST, AND NAIL TECHNICIAN LICENSING ACT AMENDMENTS, by Representative M. Newbold, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 12, Lines 348 through 353:
  - 348 (iv) (A) having graduated from a recognized master esthetics school { or a recognized
  - **349** <u>cosmetology/barber school</u>} located in a state other than Utah whose curriculum consists of less
  - 350 <u>than 1,200 hours of instruction, with full flexibility within the 1,200 hours or the equivalent</u>
  - 351 <u>number of credit hours; and</u>
  - 352 (B) having practiced as a licensed master esthetician for a period of not less than 4,000 hours;
