Mr. Speaker:

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.C.R. 8**, CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ON FEDERAL HEALTH CARE REFORM, by Representative D. Clark, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 26 through Page 2, Line 30:*

26       ▶ urges that ~~{;}~~ should Congress pass, and the President sign, legislation that  
          further  
27   restricts states in any manner, the legislation recognize states' efforts to reform  
28   health care by grandfathering any state laws, regulations, or practices intended to contain  
      costs,  
29   improve quality, increase consumerism, or otherwise implement health system reform  
30   concepts.

2. *Page 4, Lines 109 through 113:*

109       BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature and the Governor urge that  
      should  
110   Congress pass, and the President sign, legislation that further restricts states in any  
      manner, ~~{that}~~  
111   the legislation recognize states' efforts to reform health care by grandfathering any state  
      laws,  
112   regulations, or practices intended to contain costs, improve quality, increase consumerism,  
      or  
113   otherwise implement health system reform concepts.
