Mr. President:

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 90**, MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE ACT AMENDMENTS, by Senator L. Hillyard, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 7, Lines 192 through 196:
 - 192 { (iii) a bachelor's degree in sociology, psychology, family sciences, or other field
 - 193 approved by the division in collaboration with the Social Worker Licensing Board and also
 - 194 documentation of 2,000 hours of supervised social work activity approved by the division in
 - 195 collaboration with the board, which is performed after completing bachelor's degree
 - 196 requirements under this Subsection (4); }
- 2. Page 7, Line 201 through Page 8, Line 214:
 - 201 {<u>(iv)</u>} <u>(iii)</u> <u>a bachelor's degree in any field if the applicant:</u>
 - 202 (A) except as provided in Subsection 58-60-205.2(2), has completed at least three
 - 203 {<u>credit</u>} <u>semester hours or four quarter</u> hours in each of the following areas:
 - 204 <u>(I) social welfare policy;</u>
 - 205 (II) human growth and development; and
 - 206 (III) social work practice methods _, as defined by rule ; and

207 { (B) an approved social work practice methods course; and } 208 { (C) one year of } (B) provides documentation that the applicant has completed at least 2,000 hours of qualifying experience under the supervision of a [licensed certified or 209 elinical social worker] mental health therapist, which experience is approved by the division in 210 collaboration with the Social Worker Licensing Board, and which is performed after 211 completion of the requirements to obtain the bachelor's degree required under this Subsection 212 (4): or 213 {(v)} successful completion of the first academic year of a Council on Social Work (iv) Education approved master's of social work curriculum and practicum; and 214

- 3. Page 8, Lines 218 through 221:
 - 218 <u>As a condition for renewal of a license under this part, a social service worker</u> <u>licensee</u>
 - 219 <u>shall, during each two-year licensure cycle, complete</u> {<u>20 hours of</u>} <u>qualified</u> <u>continuing</u>
 - 220 professional education, as defined by rule made in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah
 - 221 Administrative Rulemaking Act.
