The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee recommends **S.J.R. 3**, JOINT RESOLUTION ON ETHICS COMPLAINT PROCEDURES, by Senator J. Valentine, be replaced and favorably recommends **1st Sub. S.J.R. 3**, JOINT RESOLUTION ON ETHICS COMPLAINT PROCEDURES with the following amendments:

1. *Page 9, Line 269 through Page 10, Line 282:*

- 269 (5) (a) A member of the commission may not receive compensation or benefits for

271 member's service, but may receive per diem and expenses incurred in the performance of

273 member's official duties at the rates established by the Division of Finance under Sections
274 63A-3-106 and 63A-3-107.
275 (b) A member may decline to receive per diem and expenses for the member's
276 service.
277 (6) (a) The commission members shall convene a meeting annually each January and
278 elect, by a majority vote, a commission chair from among the commission members.
279 (b) A person may not serve as chair for more than two consecutive years.
