MOTION:    Rep. Hendrickson moved to approve the minutes of the February 22, 2010 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Ferry absent for the vote.

**H.B. 402     Department of Administrative Services Modifications (Rep. S. Clark)**

Rep. Clark explained the bill to the committee, assisted by Kim Hood, Executive Director Administrative Services.
