**MOTION:** Rep. Beck moved to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2010 meeting. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Ferry, Rep. Litvack, Rep. Ray, Rep. Seelig and Rep. Wiley absent for the vote.

**H.B. 178 Bureau of Criminal Identification Fee Amendments (Rep. E. Hutchings)**

Rep. Hutchings presented the bill to the committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. Greenwood moved to adopt 1st. Substitute H.B. 178. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Ferry, Rep. Litvack, Rep. Ray, Rep. Seelig and Rep. Wiley absent for the vote.

**MOTION:** Rep. Aagard moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 5, Line 147:

147            ~~{(2) Fees may be modified under Subsection (1) pursuant to Section~~  
~~63J-1-504.}~~

The motion to amend passed unanimously, with Rep. Ferry, Rep. Litvack, Rep. Ray, Rep. Seelig

and Rep. Wiley absent for the vote.

**1st Sub. H.B. 234 Opting Out of the Real Id Act (Rep. S. Sandstrom)**

**H.C.R. 7 Credit Scores Concurrent Resolution (Rep. D. Aagard)**

Rep. Aagard presented the bill with the assistance of Mr. Al Bingham, a mortgage loan officer. A video power point was presented.

MOTION: Rep. Aagard moved to amend the bill as follows:

*1. Page 2, Lines 56 through 57:*

- 56 that consumers have the right to access their Fair Isaac Corporation credit scores or any other source for credit scores used by Fannie Mae, Freddie Mac, or Ginnie Mae from the three  
57 major credit agencies annually at no cost.

The motion to amend passed unanimously, with Rep. Ferry and Rep. Ray absent for the vote.

**H.B. 276 Sex Offender Registry Amendment (Rep. P. Ray)**

MOTION: Rep. Beck moved to pass the bill out with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Ferry, Rep. Litvack and Rep. Ray. absent for the vote.

**H.B. 82 Protection of Children Riding in Motor Vehicles (Rep. F.J. Seegmiller)**

Rep. Seegmiller presented the bill to the committee with the assistance of Chief Stephen Chapman, Sandy City Police Chief. (handout)
