MOTION: Rep. Ray moved to approve the minutes of the February 19, 2010 meeting. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Litvack, Rep. Seelig and Rep. Wimmer absent for the vote.

H.B. 348 Sheriffs Fees (Rep. R. Greenwood)

Rep. Greenwood presented the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Greenwood moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 4, Lines 102 through 103:

102 (b) The fee amount described in Subsection (7)(a) ~~{ does not apply if }~~ cannot
be changed by a county legislative
103 body ~~{ has set the fee amount }~~ under Subsection (1).

The motion to amend passed unanimously, with Rep. Litvack and Rep. Seelig absent for the vote.

S.B. 102 *Restricting the Movement of a Motor Vehicle (Sen. B. Goodfellow)*
