Rep. Webb called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m.

H.B. 282 Local Government Amendments (*Rep. S. Sandstrom*)

Rep. Sandstrom explained 1st Substitute H.B. 282 to the committee. Questions from the committee were discussed.

1. Page 4, Line 88:

88 storage, equipment storage, food processing or preparing, { ~~or~~ } vehicle storage or maintenance, or similar use

2. *Page 13, Line 374:*

374 (g) for a land use or a structure owned or operated by a school district or charter school that is not

3. *Page 17, Line 518:*

518 storage, equipment storage, food processing or preparing, ~~or~~ vehicle storage or maintenance, or similar use

4. *Page 27, Line 819:*

819 (g) for a land use or a structure owned or operated by a school district or charter school that is not
