H.B. 238 Low Speed Vehicle Amendments (*Rep. J. Anderson*)

Rep. Anderson introduced the bill to the committee.

Spoke to the bill: Chip Dawson, South Jordan City

MOTION: Rep. Anderson moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 27 through Page 2, Line 34:

27 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a low-speed vehicle is considered a
28 motor vehicle for purposes of the Utah Code including requirements for:

- 29 (a) traffic rules under Title 41, Chapter 6a, Traffic Code;
- 30 (b) driver licensing under Title 53, Chapter 3, Uniform Driver License Act;
- 31 (c) motor vehicle insurance under Title 41, Chapter 12a, Financial Responsibility of
- 32 Motor Vehicle Owners and Operators Act;
- 33 (d) vehicle registration, titling, ~~{odometer statements,}~~ vehicle identification
- 34 numbers,
license plates, and registration fees under Title 41, Chapter 1a, Motor Vehicle Act;

The motion to amend passed unanimously, with Rep. Cosgrove, Rep. Mascaro, and Rep. Seegmiller absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Daw moved to pass the bill out favorably as amended.
