**S.B. 17 Uniform Commercial Driver License Act Amendments (*Sen. K. Van Tassell*)

**H.B. 261 Financial Responsibility of Motor Vehicle Owners and Operators Act
Amendments (*Rep. R. Greenwood*)**

1. *Page 1, Line 20:*

agent provides certain notices to the owner of the motor vehicle. =

2. *Page 5, Lines 132 through 134:*

132 (1) If the comparison under Section 41-12a-803 shows that a motor vehicle is not
133 insured for {~~two~~} **three** consecutive months, the Motor Vehicle Division shall
direct that the designated
134 agent provide notice to the owner of the motor vehicle that the owner has 15 days to
provide:
