 - (1) If the comparison under Section 41-12a-803 shows that a motor vehicle is not
 - insured for {two} three consecutive months, the Motor Vehicle Division shall direct that the designated
 - agent provide notice to the owner of the motor vehicle that the owner has 15 days to provide:
