1. **S.B. 274 Online Pharmacy Amendments** (*Bramble*)

Sen. Bramble explained the bill and answered questions from the committee.

2. **H.B. 193 Occupations and Professions Amendments** (*R. Lockhart*)

Rep. Lockhart introduced the bill.

Mark Steinagel, Director, Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing clarified the bill and answered questions from the committee.
