 - 79 $\left[\frac{(4)}{(7)}\right]$ A resident association may not $\stackrel{\cdot}{\underline{}}$
 - (a) impose fees, dues, or assessments, upon its
 - members unless a majority of the members agree to the [assessment] imposition of fees, dues,
 - 81 or assessments $\{-\}$ <u>; or</u>
 - (b) harass or threaten a park operator.
