1. S.B. 114 -- Motor Vehicle Accident Reports

Sen. Stowell introduced and explained the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Van Tassell moved to adopt the following amendment to S.B. 114:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 15:
 - requires a peace officer investigating a motor vehicle accident to :
 - provide the owner
 - of livestock injured or killed in the motor vehicle accident a copy of the motor
 - vehicle accident report; or
 - notify the owner of livestock injured or killed in the motor vehicle

accident where a copy of the motor vehicle accident report can be obtained;

- 2. *Page 2, Lines 36 through 37:*
 - 36 (iii) (A) provide the owner of the livestock a copy of the accident report prepared in
 - 37 <u>accordance with Section 41-6a-404</u> : or

(B) notify the owner of the livestock where a copy of the accident report prepared in accordance with Section 41-6a-404 can be obtained .

Debbie Johnson, Legislative Liaison, Department of Public Safety and Utah Highway Patrol spoke against the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Hinkins moved to pass S.B.114 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Goodfellow absent for the vote.

Sen. Van Tassell assumed the chair.

MOTION: Sen. Hinkins moved to approve the minutes

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Goodfellow absent for the vote.

2. S.B. 26 -- Utah E-commerce Integrity Act

4. S.B. 104 -- Renewable Energy Modifications
