AMENDMENT 1

Representative **Paul Ray** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 14:

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

- 12 This bill modifies the Insurance Code by requiring an insurance company providing
- 13 health or dental policies to coordinate benefits for an insured individual housed in a
- correctional facility , county jail, or who is in the custody of the Department of Corrections. 14
- Page 1, Lines 17 through 20: 2.
  - 17 provides that, if an insured is otherwise eligible for health or dental benefits under a
  - 18 policy, an insurer may not exclude coverage for an insured who:
  - 19 is an inmate housed in a correctional facility; { or }
  - 20 is an offender in the custody of the Department of Corrections; or
    - is an inmate housed in a county jail.
- Page 1, Lines 22 through 23:
  - 22 an inmate housed in a correctional facility; {-or-}
  - 23 an offender in the custody of the Department of Corrections; or
    - an inmate housed in a county jail.
- Page 3, Lines 86 through 89:
  - 86 (6) If an insured is otherwise eligible for benefits under a health or dental policy, the
  - 87 insurer may not exclude coverage if the insured is an:
  - 88 (a) inmate housed in a correctional facility as defined in Section 64-13-1; {or}
  - 89 (b) offender in the custody of the Department of Corrections {-}
    - (c) inmate housed in a county jail.
- Page 4, Lines 107 through 108:
  - 107 (i) inmate housed in a correctional facility as defined in Section 64-13-1; {or}
  - 108 (ii) offender in the custody of the Department of Corrections {-}
    - (iii) inmate housed in a county jail.
