### UNLAWFUL PROVISION OF IDENTIFIABLE PRESCRIPTION INFORMATION

Representative **Jackie Biskupski** proposes the following amendments:

*1. Page 4, Lines 106 through 111:*

106 (f) to transfer information as part of a transfer of pharmacy ownership;

(g) to conduct clinical research;

107 {~~(g)~~} (h) to comply with a court order; or

108 {~~(h)~~} (i) for any other purpose expressly permitted by law.

109 (4) A person is not guilty of a violation of Subsection (1), if :

(a) the person engages in the

110 conduct described in Subsection (1) with the consent of the person to whom the information

111 relates {~~.~~} ; or

(b) at the time the person provides, sells, or permits the use of identifiable prescription information, the person to whom the identifiable prescription information is provided, sold, or disclosed signs a statement agreeing not to use the identifiable prescription information in a manner that is prohibited by this section
