Representative **John G. Mathis** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 9 through 10:
 - 9 This bill {-prohibits, in certain circumstances, the prosecution of a county surveyor or a
 - 10 professional land surveyor for criminal trespass. } provides a defense to criminal trespass that the person is a professional surveyor or county surveyor.
- 2. Page 1, Lines 14 through 15:
 - 14 {-prohibits, in certain circumstances, the prosecution of a county surveyor or a
 - 15 <u>professional land surveyor for criminal trespass</u> <u>provides a defense to criminal trespass that the</u> person is a professional surveyor or county surveyor ; and
- 3. Page 2, Line 48 through Page 3, Line 62:
 - 48 (4) (a) As used in this Subsection (4):
 - (i) "Professional land surveying or the practice of land surveying" is as defined in Section 58-22-102.
 - (ii) "Professional land surveyor" is as defined in Section 58-22-102.
 - (iii) "Surveyor" means a professional land surveyor and a county surveyor.
 - **(b)** It is a defense to prosecution under this section that:
 - 49 {(a)} (i)(A) the property was open to the public when the actor entered or remained; and
 - 50 (B) the actor's conduct did not substantially interfere with the owner's use of the
 - 51 property $\{-\}$; or
 - (ii)(A) the actor:
 - (I) is a surveyor or a designee of the surveyor engaged in professional land surveying or the practice of land surveying; or
 - (II) in the case of a county surveyor or designee of the county surveyor, is acting under the scope of authority under Title 17, Chapter 23, County Surveyor; and
 - (B) the actor's conduct did not substantially interfere with the owner's use of the property.
 - $\{(5) (a) \text{ As used in this Subsection } (5):$
 - 53 (i) "Professional land surveying or the practice of land surveying" is as defined in
 - 54 <u>Section 58-22-102.</u>
 - 55 (ii) "Professional land surveyor" is as defined in Section 58-22-102.
 - 56 (iii) "Surveyor" means a professional land surveyor and a county surveyor.

(b) A surveyor does not commit criminal trespass if when the surveyor enters and
remains on the property, the surveyof (i) (A) is engaged in professional land surveying or the practice of land surveying; or
(B) in the case of a county surveyor or a designee of the county surveyor, is acting under the scope of authority under Title 17, Chapter 23, County Surveyor; and
(ii) is not acting in violation of this section.
