Representative Paul Ray proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 18:
 - for services provided at a health care facility, payment is at {-the-} {-noncapitated}
 - state Medicaid rate in effect at the time the service was provided \ 60\% of the amount that would be paid under the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program; and
 - for services of a health care provider, payment is at {-110% of the noncapitated}
 - state Medicaid rate in effect at the time the service was provided } ; 65% of the amount that would be paid under the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program; {and }
- 2. Page 1, Line 21:
 - 21 private insurer that is in effect at the time of the service : and
 - <u>The Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program shall provide information to the department that enables the department to calculate the amount to be paid to a health care facility, and this information shall be kept confidential</u>.
- 3. Page 3, Lines 61 through 64:
 - 61 (a) service at a health care facility at { the noncapitated state Medicaid rate in effect at
 - 62 the time the service was provided and Insurance Program, created in Section 49-20-103; and
 - 63 (b) a health care provider at { 110% of the noncapitated state Medicaid rate in effect at
 - 64 the time the service was provided 65% of the amount that would be paid under the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program, created in Section 49-20-103 .
- 4. Page 3, Line 67:
 - 67 <u>that covers those expenses.</u>
 - (9)(a) The Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program shall provide information to the department that enables the department to calculate the amount to be paid to a health care facility under Subsection (7)(a) or a health care provider under Subsection (7)(b).
 - (b) The department shall keep information provided under Subsection (9)(a) confidential.
