Senator **Ross I. Romero** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 18 through 20*

Senate 3rd Reading Amendments

2-24-2010:

- 18 ▶ provides that a violation is a reportable violation; ~~{and}~~
- 19 ▶ ~~requires~~ prohibits ~~the~~ Driver License Division ~~to assess~~ from
- 19a ~~assessing~~ ~~points~~ against a person's driving
- 20 record for being convicted of violating the wireless telephone prohibition ~~;~~ **and**
- provides that enforcement for a violation of the prohibition on using a wireless telephone while operating a motor vehicle shall only be as a secondary action when the vehicle has been detained for a suspected violation of certain offenses** .

2. *Page 2, Lines 52a through 53*

Senate 3rd Reading Amendments

2-24-2010:

- 52a ~~convicted in accordance~~
- 53 ~~with~~ who violates this section under ~~Section~~ 53-3-221.
- (5) Enforcement of this section by a state or local law enforcement officer shall be only as a secondary action when the vehicle has been detained for a suspected violation by any person in the vehicle of Title 41, Motor Vehicles, other than this section, or for another offense.**
