**HOSPITAL ASSESSMENTS**

Representative **Kevin S. Garn** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 6, Lines 169 through 170e

(C) For fiscal years 2011-12 and 2012-13 the department may generate an additional amount from  
the assessment imposed under Subsection(d)(i) in the amount of \$1,000,000 to offset Medicaid mandatory
