Senator **Benjamin M. McAdams** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 24 through 24b*

Senate Committee Amendments

3-2-2010:

24 issues an indictment ~~§~~; ~~{and}~~

24a ► clarifies that only DNA markers used for forensic purposes may be included when

24b establishing a donor's ~~{DNA profile}~~ **gender and unique individual identification by DNA analysis;**

and

► requires that the DNA analysis be consistent with and not exceed FBI forensic DNA analysis procedures. ←§

2. *Page 10, Lines 289b through 290*

(h) utilize only those DNA analysis procedures that are consistent with, and do not exceed, procedures established and used by the Federal Bureau of Investigation for the forensic analysis of DNA; and

3. *Page 11, Line 324:*

324 conviction, judgment, or order, **a certified copy of a court order to set aside the conviction,** or a certified copy of the dismissal or acquittal of the charge
