RESPECTING OUR FALLEN HEROES ACT

LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill increases the distance a disruptive activity is to be from a memorial service of a person who served in the armed forces or who was a member of the National Guard.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- defines a military memorial service to be a memorial service of a person who served in the armed forces or who was a member of the National Guard; and

- requires a disruptive activity to be at least ~~1,000~~ 500 feet away from a military memorial service.
