65 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah, the  
66 Governor concurring therein, urge the United States Government and the Secretary of the  
67 Interior to provide continued financial assistance to the unincorporated community of Dutch  
68 John, Utah, in the amount of at least \$500,000 annually, as adjusted by the Secretary of the  
69 Interior for changes in the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers published by the  
70 Department of Labor, from the Upper Colorado River Basin Fund for a period not to exceed 15  
71 years, for the purpose of defraying costs of administration and the provision of basic  
72 community services.

73 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the United  
74 States Secretary of the Interior, the members of Utah's congressional delegation, the United  
75 States Forest Service, the Bureau of Reclamation, and the Daggett County Commission.
