*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

#### Section 1. **Rules reauthorized.**

All rules of Utah state agencies are reauthorized except for the following:

(1) R311-201-11, Environmental Quality, Environmental Response and Remediation, Underground Storage Tanks: Certification Programs and UST Operator Training, Work Performed by Licensed Engineers or Geologists; and

(2) R311-207-9, Environmental Quality, Environmental Response and Remediation, Accessing the Petroleum Storage Tank Trust Fund for Leaking Petroleum Storage Tanks, Third Party Consultant.

#### Section 2. **Effective date.**

If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this bill takes effect May 1, 2011.
