LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill appropriates money for a veterans' home in Utah County.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill appropriates for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2012:

▶ to the Division of Facilities and Construction Management, as a one-time appropriation:

- from the Veterans' Nursing Home Reimbursement Restricted Fund, \$6,350,000.

Money Appropriated in this Bill:

This bill appropriates:

- ▶ \$6,350,000 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2012.

ENACTS UNCODIFIED MATERIAL

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. **Appropriations for construction of a veterans' home in Utah County.**

Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures Act, the following sums of money are appropriated from resources not otherwise appropriated out of the



28 funds or accounts indicated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30,
29 2012. These sums are additions to amounts previously appropriated for fiscal year 2012.
