8 **Committee Note:**

9 The Executive Appropriations Committee recommended this bill.

10 **General Description:**

11 This bill appropriates funds for the support and operation of state government for the fiscal
12 year beginning July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2012.

13 **Highlighted Provisions:**

14 This bill:

- 15 ▶ provides appropriations for the use and support of certain state agencies;
- 16 ▶ provides appropriations for other purposes as described;

17 **Money Appropriated in this Bill:**

18 This bill appropriates for fiscal year 2012:

- 19 ▶ \$490,632,850 from the General Fund;
- 20 ▶ \$45,600 from the Education Fund;
- 21 ▶ \$219,556,100 from various sources as detailed in this bill.

22 **Other Special Clauses:**

23 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2011.
