resources, desires to remove its district court operations from the city of Orem;
WHEREAS, removal of district court operations from the city of Orem will leave a
district court in three municipalities to serve the citizens of Utah County; and
WHEREAS, Subsection 78A-5-111(2)(c) requires that removal of a district court from



a municipality in which a circuit court formerly existed have legislative approval by joint
