Mr. President:

The Transportation and Public Utilities and Technology Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 28**, PENALTIES FOR UNAUTHORIZED USE OF RECORDS, by Representative R. Greenwood, with the following amendments and recommends it be considered read for the second time and placed on the Consent Calendar:

- 1. *Page 1, Lines 15 through 17:*
 - provides that the <u>knowing or intentional</u> unauthorized <u>access</u>, use <u>adisclosure</u>, or dissemination of records created or maintained by the Motor
 - 16 Vehicle Division, the Driver License Division, or the Criminal Investigations and
 - 17 Technical Services Division is a class B misdemeanor;
- 2. *Page 3, Lines 88 through 89:*
 - 88 {<u>(10) (a) Unauthorized use of records created or maintained by the division is</u>
 a class B
 - 89 misdemeanor. (10)(a) It is a class B misdemeanor for a person to knowingly or intentionally access, use, disclose, or disseminate a record created or maintained by the division or any information contained in a record created or maintained by the division for a purpose not permitted or prohibited by statute, rule, regulation, or policy of a governmental entity.
- 3. Page 6, Lines 168 through 169:

- 168 (8) (a) { Unauthorized use of records created or maintained by the division is a class B
- 169 misdemeanor.

 It is a class B misdemeanor for a person to knowingly or intentionally access, use, disclose, or disseminate a record created or maintained by the division or any information contained in a record created or maintained by the division for a purpose not permitted or prohibited by statute, rule, regulation, or policy of a governmental entity.
- 4. Page 9, Lines 268 through 270:
 - 268 (11) (a) [Misuse of access to criminal history record information] {<u>Unauthorized</u> use of
 - 269 <u>records created or maintained, or to which access is granted by the division is a class</u>

 - 270 misdemeanor. } It is a class B misdemeanor for a person to knowingly or intentionally access, use, disclose, or disseminate a record created, maintained, or to which access is granted by the division or any information contained in a record created, maintained, or to which access is granted by the division for a purpose not permitted or prohibited by statute, rule, regulation, or policy of a governmental entity.
