The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee recommends **H.B. 76**, FEDERAL LAW EVALUATION AND RESPONSE, by Representative K. Ivory, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 76**, FEDERAL LAW EVALUATION AND RESPONSE with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 34:

     <u>Subsection (1)(d); and</u>
     (d) by the Public Lands Policy Coordinating Office for litigation costs associated

with the council's duties established in this chapter.
