Madam Speaker:

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 79**,
PROPERTY AND CASUALTY CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE ACT, by Representative T. Kiser,
with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 16 through 23:*

- 16 ▶ requires filing of forms, with exceptions;
- 17 ▶ addresses the scope of certificates of insurance;
- 18 ▶ requires certain language to be included in a certificate of insurance;
- 19 { → ~~provides for the charging of a service fee;~~ }
- 20 ▶ prohibits false and misleading practices;
- 21 ▶ addresses notice requirements;
- 22 ▶ provides for enforcement; and
- 23 ▶ authorizes rulemaking.

2. *Page 3, Line 89 through Page 4, Line 91:*

- 89 Section 4. Section **31A-22-1704** is enacted to read:
- 90 31A-22-1704. Scope of certificate of insurance -- Required statement { ~~---Fee~~ } .
- 91 (1) A certificate of insurance is not an insurance policy and does not affirmatively or
