NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

March 2, 2011

Madam Speaker:

With committee review, the Judiciary Committee has returned **H.B. 205**, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND DATING VIOLENCE AMENDMENTS, by Representative P. Ray, to the Rules Committee with the following amendments, and recommends that it be sent to interim study.

- 1. Page 21, Lines 644 through 645:
 - (v) ordering any other relief that the court considers necessary to protect and provide
 - for the safety of the victim and any designated family or household member hete defendant is charged with violating a protective order relating to dating partners, as defined in Section 78B-7-102, the court may not prohibit the defendant from purchasing, using, or possessing a firearm, unless the court finds that the defendant's use or possession of a firearm is likely to pose a serious threat of harm to the victim.
- 2. Page 23, Lines 688 through 689:
 - (e) prohibiting the perpetrator from purchasing, using, or possessing a firearm or other
 - specified weapon _____, except that, if the defendant is convicted of violating a protective order relating to dating partners, as defined in Section 78B-7-102, the court may not prohibit the defendant from purchasing, using, or possessing a firearm, unless the court finds that the defendant's use or possession of a firearm is likely to pose a serious threat of harm to the victim_____;

3. Page 33, Lines 1006 through 1008:

1006 [(d)] (e) upon finding that the respondent's use or possession of a weapon may pose a
1007 serious threat of harm to the petitioner, or, if the order relates to dating partners, that
the respondent's use or possession of a weapon is likely to pose a threat of harm to the
petitioner, prohibit the respondent from purchasing, using, or

possessing a firearm or other weapon specified by the court;
