Madam Speaker:

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 336, MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL LICENSING DURING A DECLARED EMERGENCY**, by Representative E. Vickers, with the following amendments:
