## NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

March 2, 2011

Madam Speaker:

With committee review, the Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee has returned **H.B. 364**, DISARMING A PEACE OFFICER, by Representative R. Greenwood, to the Rules Committee without recommendation with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 17:
  - in or about a courthouse or courtroom or a secure area in the courthouse; {-and--}
  - provides that court personnel may not take or remove the peace officer's firearm
  - while the officer is acting within the officer's scope of authority {--} : and provides for an exception.
- 2. Page 2, Line 49:
  - 49 (4) (A) (a) Except as otherwise provided in Subsection (4)(b), a peace officer, while acting within the scope of authority as a peace officer, is
- 3. Page 2, Line 52:
  - 52 secure area, and acting within the officer's scope of authority.
    - (b) A responsible law enforcement agency of the court, such as a sheriff's office, may make rules regarding the transporting of a prisoner from one holding cell to another within a court facility in which the peace officer transporting the prisoner is not to carry a firearm.
