## NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

March 2, 2011

Madam Speaker:

With committee review, the Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee has returned **H.B. 364**, DISARMING A PEACE OFFICER, by Representative R. Greenwood, to the Rules Committee without recommendation with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 15 through 17:*

15 in or about a courthouse or courtroom or a secure area in the courthouse; {~~and~~}  
16       ▶ provides that court personnel may not take or remove the peace officer's firearm  
17 while the officer is acting within the officer's scope of authority {~~.~~} ; and  
provides for an exception.

2. *Page 2, Line 49:*

49       (4) {~~A~~} (a) Except as otherwise provided in Subsection (4)(b), a peace  
officer, while acting within the scope of authority as a peace officer, is

3. *Page 2, Line 52:*

52 secure area, and acting within the officer's scope of authority. (b) A responsible law enforcement agency of the court, such as a sheriff's office,  
may make rules regarding the transporting of a prisoner from one holding cell to  
another within a court facility in which the peace officer transporting the prisoner is  
not to carry a firearm.
